

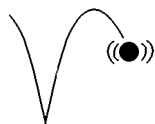

Event Eligibility Ratings as of October 10 will be used for eligibility; October 15 for seeding. Unrated players may not advance from the round robin in rating-limited events, and may not enter doubles. Where adequate supporting evidence exists, tournament director may assign ratings for unrated players, who are then eligible to advance to the playoffs and enter doubles. Email, call, or text us per the “Information” paragraph below if you can’t find your last rating. Rated players with outdated or clearly inaccurate ratings may be re-rated. Events with insufficient entries may be cancelled and fees refunded.

Rules & Equipment You must be a member of USATT or ITTF, or purchase a 1-weekend tournament pass for \$20. Adult Silver membership is \$50/year, or \$75 for Gold level. Please pay for your membership, if needed, with your entry payment. All USATT-approved equipment: 9 Butterfly Nippon tables, Nittaku 3-Star Premium 40+ white balls. USATT rules including dress code will be enforced, clothing must not be white or near-white and the ball must clearly contrast. Tournament Director and Referee: Sam Steiner (CR/CU). Wooden gym floor with bright 400 lux LED lighting. Gym opens at 9:00am.

Directions Boys & Girls Club of Erie, 1515 East Lake Road, Erie, Pennsylvania, 16511, back entrance. Coming from the West or South, take I-90 or I-79, then I-79 north to the 12th St (Route 5) exit. Turn right (east) on 12th. Follow 12th St through Erie about 3.4 miles, turning left (north) onto the Bayfront Parkway. Go 1/2 mile and turn right (east) onto East 6th St. Take 6th St. about 1 mile, it turns into East Lake Road at East Ave. Stay in the right lane as you approach East Ave, but don’t exit to the right. Go another 1/2 mile to the Boys & Girls Club at the Gilson Ave. light. Turn right on Gilson and go to the back parking lot. Coming from the East, exit I-90 at Route 430 North/Bayfront Connector. Take the Bayfront Connector 6.5 miles north and turn right onto East 6th St, then proceed as per above instructions. Small snacks will be the only food available on-site or in the immediate area. Please arrive at least 1/2 hour before your scheduled starting time.
